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
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EMS Score Profile

40-44	15-27	Mild Difficulties With Everyday Memory Tasks	
29-39	2-14	Moderate Difficulties With Everyday Memory Tasks	
Below 29	Below 2	Significant Difficulties With Everyday Memory Tasks
