-1 SD	85	1.0	1.0
-1.33 SD*	80	.85	1.0

-2 SD	70	.30	1.0

* Best balance between sensitivity & specificity measures—the optimal cut score.

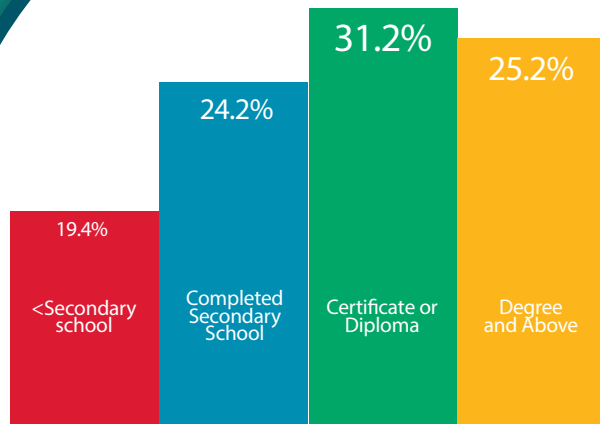
