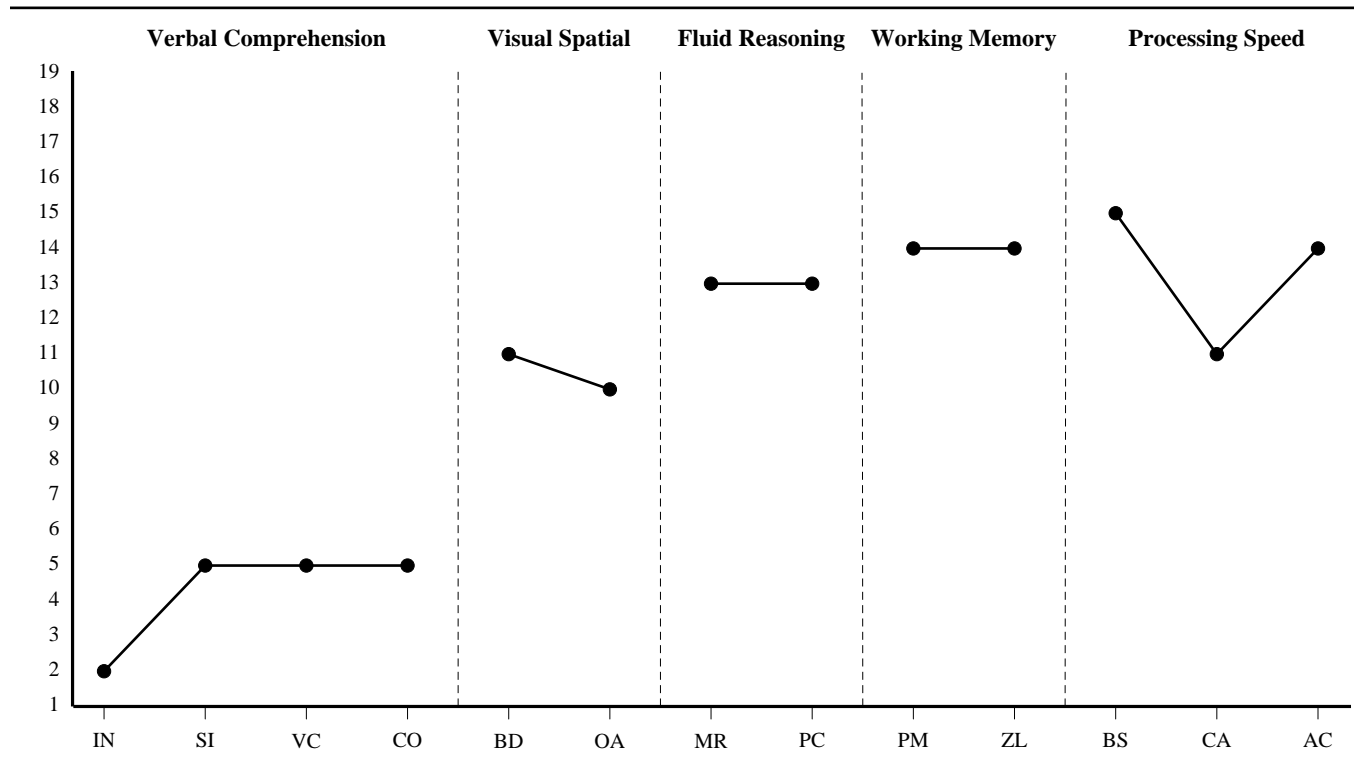

Subtest Scaled Score Profile



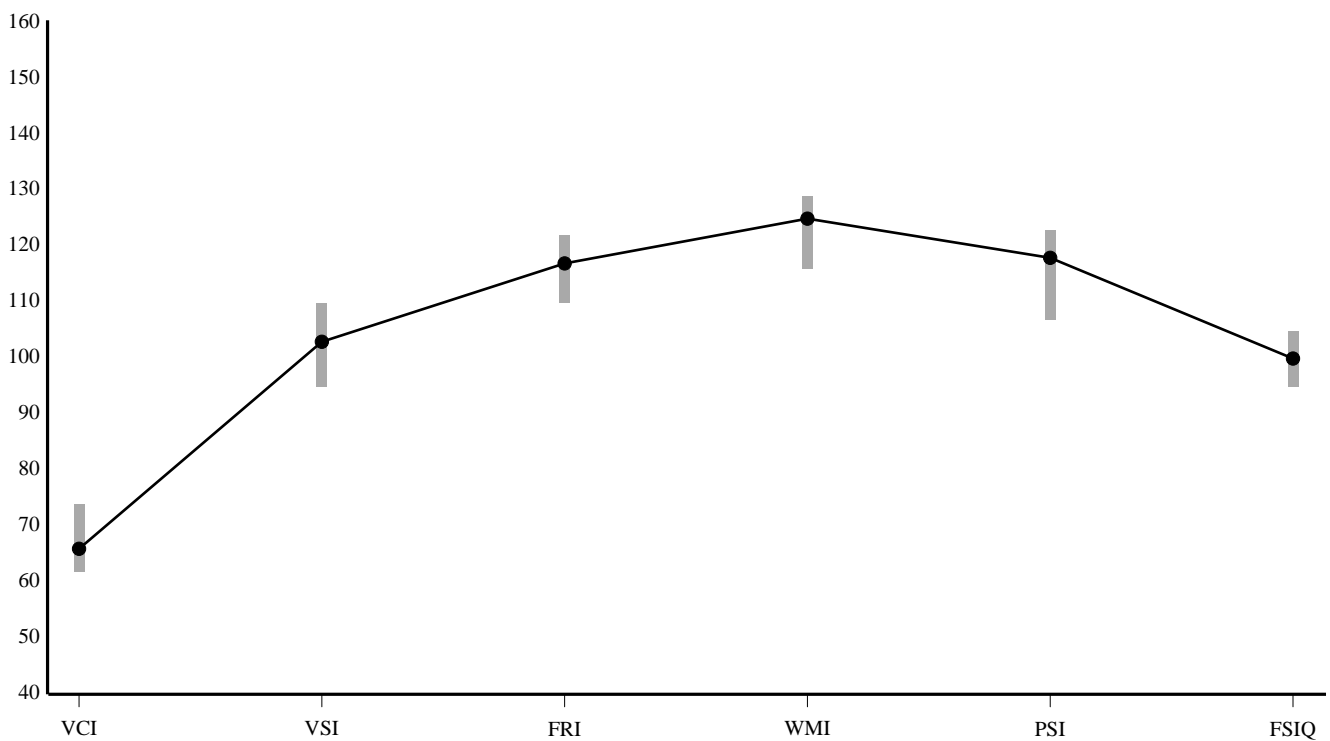

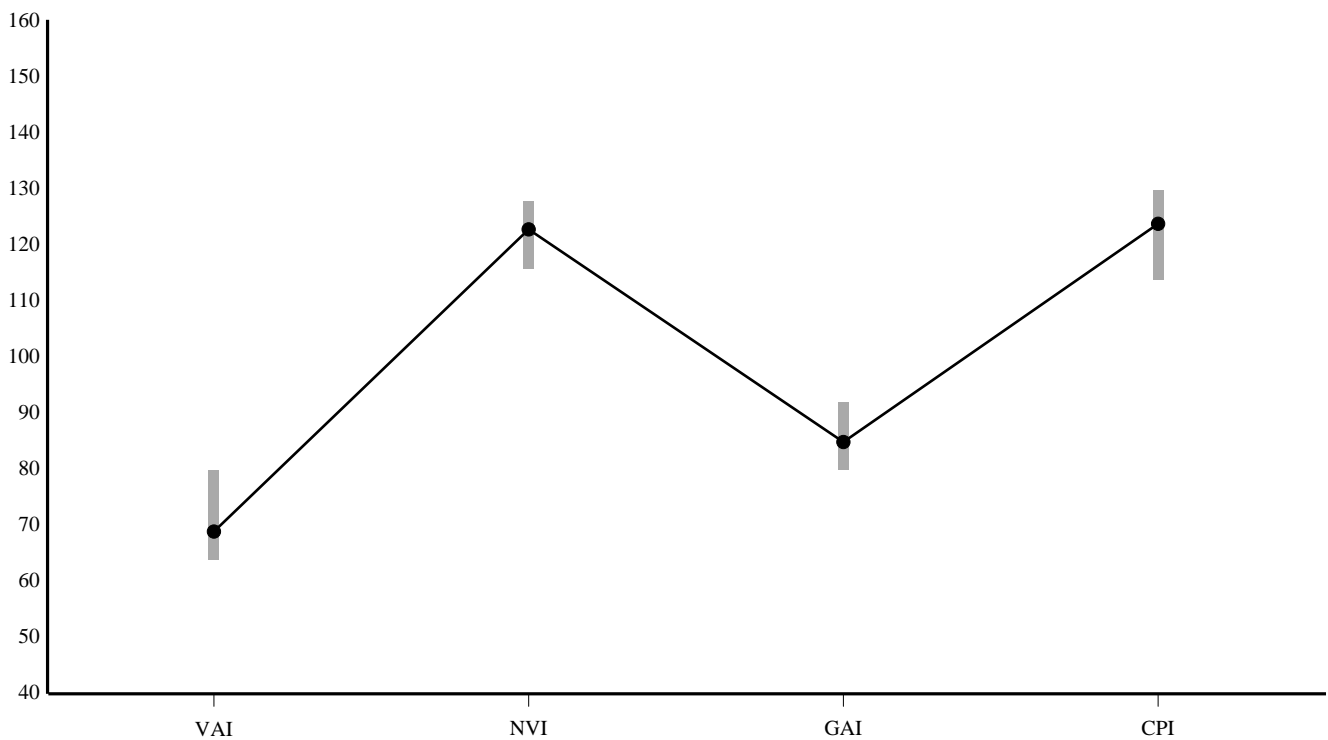
